The L2E Program does not provide scholarships to students pursuing a 4-year bachelor's degree.

Scholarship Application

In addition to the application, two letters of recommendation are to be submitted. Additional letters of recommendation or other materials can also be submitted by the applicant if desired. Candidates are to submit an application to L2E only after the candidate has submitted an application to a program. All L2E application materials should be sent to Dr. Bruce Mousa at bmousa@ufl.edu.

After submission of a complete set of application materials, the application will be reviewed by L2E representatives and the candidate may be contacted for a further personal interview. Determination of financial assistance will be made on a timely basis as soon as it is possible.
