LEARNER RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

It's our school's responsibility to inform all students that sometimes accommodations for testing such as extended time or testing in a separate room are available. Accommodations for instruction are also possible.

If you previously had any special services in school, or think you might currently have a condition which affects your ability to learn or to take tests, please talk with an Advisor. Persons with disabilities are protected under law with the right to accommodations in instruction and testing.

Each students has the **RIGHT**

- To participate in adult education programs, services, and activities without discrimination
- To choose whether to disclose a disability
- To receive reasonable accommodations in class and on tests
- To meet with staff to discuss his/her need

Each student has the **RESPONSIBILITY**

- To self-identify or notify a teacher, Advisor, or registrar if he/she needs or wishes to request accommodations for testing or instruction
- To provide documentation from **Vocational Rehab (VR)** or a private agency of his/her disability
- All documentation is required and will be kept totally confidential

Accommodations may include, but are not limited to

- Extra time for testing
- Frequent rest or breaks
- Special test settings
